ACCESS TO BOARDWALKS AND BEACHES

- Ramps from street to beach at 83rd, 88th, 90th, 95th, 101st, 114th and 119th Streets
- Access from beach entrance to water's edge at 88th, 95th and 119th Sts.
- There is access to pavilions at 88th and 101st Streets, and there is access from the pavilions to the beach at those locations

SURF CHAIRS

Locations:

- A total of 6 chairs are available at Beach Tag Office at 95th Street & Beach
- Beach Tag Office hours are 10 am to 4 pm

Reservations:

- Reservations (No Charge) are strongly suggested (609-368-6805)

ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

- There are portable rest rooms with accessible stalls on the 82nd Street Recreation Field, 95th Street and the beach, and the 123rd Street Parking Lot at the beach

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- Located at 95th Street & Beach
- There is No Charge for on-street metered parking for motor vehicles that properly display a handicapped windshield placard or license plate

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The Fishing Pier at 83rd Street and the bay is now fully accessible.
- The 95th street crossover has a large deck with a view of the ocean.

ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

- No public rest rooms are available
- Portable rest room with 1 accessible stall is available at Williams Ave and Putnam Ave

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- On-street parking at Neptune Road, Prescott Ave, and Putnam Ave

ACCESS TO BOARDWALKS AND BEACHES

- Access ramps to boardwalk at Schellenger Ave and Rio Grande
- At Cresse Ave (beyond boardwalk), there is direct access to the beach
- Beach Patrol will provide transport from the boardwalk onto the soft sand for person with disabilities and 1 companion after 11am and will provide return transport to the boardwalk before 4pm

SURF CHAIRS

Location:

- There are a total of 2-3 chairs available
- All are located at the Beach Patrol Headquarters at Lincoln Ave & Ocean
- There is No Charge for use of chairs

Reservations:

- Chairs are available on a first come, first served basis
- Reservations are strongly encouraged (609-522-8258) but will be accepted no more than 2 days prior to date(s) requested
- Chairs may be reserved for more than 1 day at a time, but must be returned each night and must stay at all times in Wildwood on the beach
- 2 forms of ID are required to reserve chairs

ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

- Accessible rest rooms (boardwalk level) are located at Glenwood, Youngs, and Leaming Aves
- At Schellenger Ave (beach level), there is a ramp from boardwalk to beach and comfort station
- Additionally, at each of the 7 beach walkways, there are accessible portable restrooms

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- Available on at least every other street at Ocean
- Accessible spaces at municipal parking lots (Rio Grande, Taylor, Leaming, Hand)

BEACH TAXI

Operates the entire length and width of the City of Wildwood Beach. Weekend service will begin Saturday, May 28th, and daily service will begin Saturday, June 11th until Sunday September 11th. The Beach Taxi's hours of operation are from 10AM- 4:30PM. Fare - Adults \$3, Seniors \$2, Disabled and Vets \$1. Phone 609-408-4714.

- Only Cresse and Washington are NOT accessible

ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

- ADA accessible rest rooms are available at the Sunrise Park at Rambler Rd

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR SAFE SURF CHAIR USE

- Use of the surf chair is restricted to those individuals weighing less than three hundred (300) pounds
- An attendant must be present when the chair is in use
- The attendant must not undertake tasks which exceed his/her physical ability
- At no time, and under no circumstances is the surf chair to be placed in the water beyond a depth of six inches.

ACCESS TO BOARDWALKS AND BEACHES

- Ramps to the boardwalk (promenade) are located at 17 streets along Beach Drive
- Ramps from the boardwalk (promenade) to the beach at Broadway, 3rd and Cove, Grant and Gurney Streets and Trenton Ave

SURF CHAIRS

Locations:

- First Ave Beach (2 chairs)
- Stegers Beach (1 chair)
- Stockton Street Beach (1 chair)
- Jefferson Ave Beach (1 chair)
- Philadelphia Ave Beach (1 chair)
- Hughes Street Beach (2 chairs)
- Poverty Beach (1 chair)
- Madison Ave Beach (1 chair)
- Beach Patrol Headquarters on Grant Street (3 chairs)

Reservations:

- Surf chairs are available (No Charge) on a first come-first served system
- A photocopy of a Driver's License is required to use the chairs
- Chairs will be delivered by the Beach Patrol
- Chairs must stay on the beach and must be returned by 4:30 pm

ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

There are 7 accessible rest rooms on the boardwalk (promenade) along Beach Drive. The locations are: Wilmington Avenue, Trenton Avenue, Philadelphia Avenue, Gurney Street, Grant Street, Broadway, and Second Avenue.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Accessible Parking is available on Beach Drive at 2nd Street, Broadway, Grant Street, Perry Street, Decatur Street, Ocean Street, Howard Street, Jefferson Street, Madison Avenue, Trenton Avenue, Pittsburgh Avenue, Philadelphia Avenue, Wilmington Avenue, and at the Convention Center.

Handicapped persons whose motor vehicles properly display a windshield placard or special license plate are exempt from paying parking meter fees throughout the City of Cape May (Ordinance 240-2011)

- There is a ramp to the beach at Coral Ave

SURF CHAIRS

- There are 2 chairs available (No Charge)
- Chairs can be requested on a daily basis at the Lifeguard Station
- Reservations are recommended (609-884-8468 Ext. 15)

ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

- There are no public rest rooms at this location

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- There is accessible parking at Borough Hall, Alexander Ave, and Coral Ave
- There is designated accessible parking close to the ramp at Coral Ave

ACCESS TO BOARDWALKS AND BEACHES

- There is ADA compliant ramp access at Inlet Beach (off the seawall), and at 7th, 10th, 15th and 20th Avenues
- There are accessible ramps from the street at 15th – 19th Avenues, 24th and 26th Avenues

SURF CHAIRS

Location:

- There are a total of 22 chairs available
- 15 are located at Beach Patrol Headquarters at 15th Ave; 4 at 5th Ave and the beach; and 3 on Inlet Beach
- There is No Charge for use of chairs

Reservations:

- Chairs are available on a first come, first served basis

ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

- Public rest rooms are located at 7th & 15th Aves at the beach

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- Available at 15th Ave & the beach and 1st & Surf Aves

ACCESS TO BOARDWALKS AND BEACHES

- Ramps (concrete) to the boardwalk at every street adjacent to the boardwalk
- Ramps to the beach at Stenton Place, 1st, 3rd, Pennlyn Place, Park Place, 4th, Brighton Place, 5th, 6th, Music Pier, 11th – 18th, 20th, 26th, 35th – 46th, 48th, 50th – 59th Streets
- Direct access to the beach at Morningside, St. James Place, 23rd, 29th, 30th, 34th and 57th Streets

SURF CHAIRS

Locations:

- Total of 54 surf chairs are available from Memorial Day through Labor Day
- 1 chair is available at each of the Lifeguard Stations at 1st, 12th, 34th and 59th Streets, to act as transport onto the beach
- The rest of the chairs are available for pickup (No Charge) at the Sports & Civic Center at 6th Street & Boardwalk between 9 am and 5 pm

Reservations:

- Reservations are encouraged; to reserve a chair, contact the Recreation Division at the Sports & Civic Center (609-525-9304) between 9 am and 5 pm
- Surf chairs can be reserved for up to 1 week or can be used on a daily basis
- Failure to pick up the chair within 24 hours of the initial reservation date will result in the cancellation of your reservation
- Both child and adult size chairs are offered

ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

- Public rest rooms are located on the boardwalk at 1st Street, 6th Street, Music Pier, 11th and 12th Street
- Public rest rooms are also available at the Sports & Civic Center and at the 34th and 59th Street Lifeguard Stations

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- There is No Charge for the parking lot located at 5th Street and Asbury Ave
- When parking at a metered space, a driver with a placard or handicapped license plate must put the appropriate amount of money in the meter. This will permit the vehicle to occupy the space for up to 24 hours, and no further payment will be required.
- Municipal parking lots do require payment and will provide convenient handicapped parking with lawful placard or handicapped license plates.

ACCESS TO BOARDWALKS AND BEACHES

- Ramps from street to the Promenade at 29th, 40th, 44th and 57th Streets
- Access to beach at, 32nd, 40th, 44th, 63rd, 85th and JFK streets
- Gazebo with picnic facilities at 85th Street entrance
- 94th Street gazebo at Townsend's Inlet Park has ramp access to the gazebo and to a decked walkway into the dunes

SURF CHAIRS

Locations:

- Chairs are available YEAR ROUND --- From Memorial Day to Labor Day at the Beach Patrol Headquarters (44th St. & Promenade), open from 9 to 4:30 daily; from Labor Day to Memorial Day through Public Works (609-263-6000), M – F, 7 to 3

Reservations:

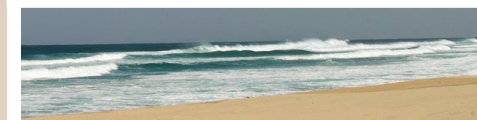
- Surf chairs are available (No Charge) on a first come-first served system
- 2 forms of ID are required
- Reservations are strongly suggested
- Chairs may be signed out for 1-14 days; on the first day of a reservation, the chair(s) must be picked up by 11:30 am
- If chairs are kept for more than 1 day, you must provide your own storage and transportation

ACCESSIBLE REST ROOMS

- Public rest rooms are located at 32nd, 40th, 44th, 85th on the beach and 94th Street at Townsend's Inlet Park
- All rest rooms have at least 1 accessible stall
- There are separate fully accessible rest rooms at 32nd and 40th Streets on the Promenade and at 85th Street at the beach

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- There are accessible parking spaces along JFK Boulevard & Promenade and at Townsend's Inlet Park at 94th Street
- Mostly metered parking
